

# Do You Have the Time?

Taking care of a pet is a big **responsibility**. Before choosing the pet you would *like* to have, determine the amount of time you are available in a day to properly care for a pet. You might find you do not have enough time each day to be a responsible pet owner for the kind of pet you want.

**Step One:** Estimate the minutes or hours each activity takes from your day.

**Step Two:** Add the numbers within each column to find the total minutes and the total hours these activities take each day.

**Step Three:** Transfer the number of total minutes you calculated on page 26 to the space inside the division problem. To convert your total minutes into hours, divide your number by 60 (the number of minutes in one hour).

Animal	Time Needed Each Day
Dog	More than 2 hours
Cat	At least 1 hour
Rabbit	At least 30 minutes
Guinea Pig	At least 30 minutes
Hamster	At least 30 minutes
Bird	At least 30-45 minutes
Reptile	Time varies per species
Fish	At least 15 minutes
