## Creating Compassion One Paw at a Time



Wayside Waifs works endlessly to rescue animals in need and find them loving homes. But did you know we also work hard to create a more compassionate world? Whether it's by preventing animal abuse, neglect, or homelessness... with adults or kids... pet owners or not... Wayside spreads compassion to all.

With your help, we save animals from neglectful situations and give them good lives. We work with others – both individuals and community groups – to help animals in need and create a more connected community.

One way we are able to share our knowledge with the community is through our Dog Training classes. Wayside offers these classes, seminars, and private training sessions, which utilize positive reinforcement, as a way to increase pet retention. Pet owners who have challenges with their dog's behavior are able to take classes from our Certified Canine Public Training Manager. They can learn how to work with and modify behaviors which not only strengthens the bond they share with their pet, but it also eliminates the need to surrender that pet to Wayside because they were able to overcome the challenges.

"The classes take place in a fun, safe, and positive environment," Mary and Joe said.

We welcome children to Wayside on a daily basis to instill positivity in how they treat pets and people. They are involved in a lot at the shelter – from animal visits to tours to projects that benefit the Waifs.

They engage in various programming offered by our Humane Education managers such as Proper Pet Care, Dog Safety, and Activating Em-PAW-thy. These programs help kids understand that their own needs are similar to our pets. They leave Wayside with more motivation to not just care for their family pets, but for all living beings.

In addition to welcoming kids to Wayside, our No More Bullying® curriculum is taught to children across the country. Locally, our Humane Educators go in to classrooms and teach the curriculum alongside their Companion Animal. Lessons from No More Bullying® focus on its five core values: Responsibility, Compassion, Being Humane, Self-Control, and Integrity. Studies prove that developing these principles in young people through the humane treatment of animals leads them to have greater empathy for human beings and helps stop violence before it starts.

Ten years ago, a Wayside employee broke the cycle of violence for Maverick (on the cover), a stray dog they found on the highway. Based on Maverick's health, he had lived a life full of abuse and was most likely being used in dog fighting. Thankfully violence stopped the day he was brought to Wayside. Our medical and behavior teams gave him life-saving care. He was adopted and given a second chance. Incredibly we learned he was the beloved pet of a 3rd grade teacher where we teach No More Bullying®! The teacher saw his photo on her students' journals and learned that his story had been shared with thousands of students over the years. It was an amazing example of how life can be bad until compassion steps in to help!



Wayside recognizes the need for compassion in everyone's lives, especially in today's world. Through our various ways of working with the public, we're able to educate others on how being kind to one another, and to pets, helps create a more empathetic community.
